FROM THE PASTOR . . .

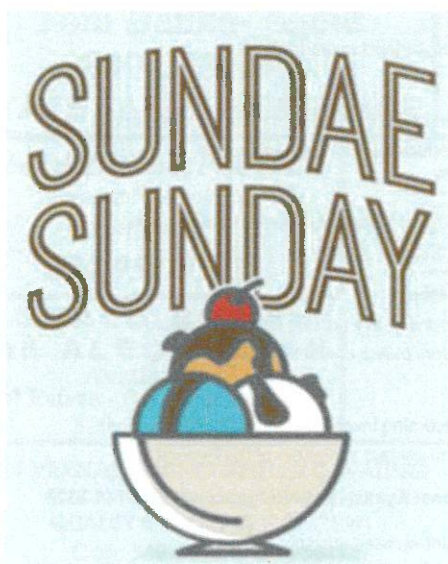
Today, we gather to celebrate **Trinity Sunday**. Trinity Sunday is the first Sunday after Pentecost to honor the Holy Trinity—the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Although the word “trinity” does not appear in Scripture, it is taught in Matthew 28:18-20 and also in 2 Corinthians 13:14 (and many other biblical passages). The concept of the trinity can never be completely understood or rationalized, but it is clearly taught in Scripture. Understanding of all scriptural doctrine is by faith which comes through the work of the Holy Spirit; therefore, it is appropriate that this mystery is celebrated the first Sunday after Pentecost, when the outpouring of the Holy Spirit first occurred.

Next weekend, as we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ**, we will begin offering Communion under both species. The two lines will remain, with the Host offered at the front of the line, and then a minister on each side with the Cup. Only the Host will be offered to the handicapped section at this time. Please, as always, take caution when receiving from the Cup. If you are experiencing any illness, refrain from receiving the Cup. Thank you. We will also have a period of Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament between the Sunday Morning Masses next Sunday. Please consider staying for a brief period after 9am Mass or come early to the 11:30am Mass for quiet prayer.

We will gather after the **11:30am Mass** on the front Piazza of the Church for Strawberry Shortcake and Ice Cream Sundaes. We will also have coffee and lemonade. 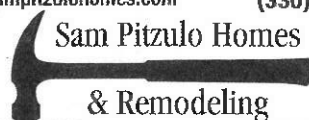
